

## GlāzOn Project #1- Memory Box Dog Tag

Project designed by Susan Holton

**Tsukineko supplies** GlāzOn; Mini Multi-Purpose Squeegee; Spongue Daubers; StāzOn reinker in Opaque Cotton White; StāzOn ink pads in Sunflower Yellow, Cactus Green, Eden Green, Forest Green, Metallic Gold

**Rubber Stamps** Memory Box- “Spring Branch” #1363, “Bird Collage” #E1102, “Porcello Flourish” #B1128

**Other Supplies** silver metal dog tag

### Project Directions



**Step 1** Apply a thin layer of GlāzOn and spread evenly across the dog tag with a Mini Squeegee, let dry completely. Apply StāzOn Opaque Cotton White with a Spongue Dauber or spread with Mini Squeegee. Let ink dry completely before adding another layer of GlāzOn and allowing to dry.

**Step 2** Begin adding color to the tag with a Spongue Dauber, allowing the StāzOn ink to dry completely before adding a layer of GlāzOn to seal each layer of ink. Sunflower yellow was added to the tag (top) and Cactus Green (bottom). Both were blended with Cotton White on each layer.



**Step 3** “Spring Branch” was stamped onto the tag in Eden Green, coat of GlāzOn; “Bird Collage” stamped in Metallic Gold, coat of GlāzOn.

**Step 4** Stamp “Porcello Flourish” in Forest Green and seal the tag with a final layer of GlāzOn.



### GlāzOn Tips

- Always put the cap on your bottle of GlazOn when not in use
- If heat setting your projects, remember that you are also “heating” your project’s surface- metal and glass become hot when heated, acrylic can warp, etc.
- GlazOn air dries perfectly
- General rule- add your StāzOn color, allow to dry, add a layer of GlāzOn, allow to dry, repeat for each color.
- Don’t forget to seal your completed project with GlāzOn
